REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

- 4. NEW BUSINESS
 - a) Discuss and take appropriate action regarding the request to:

 Treasures Harvey Davis. Councilwoman O'Neal made a motion, seconded by
 Councilwoman Blake to appoint a budget committee. The motion carried

The city is applying for a grant to pay \$9,740 and if successful, 75% will be paid. Councilman Valdez Certifying Official and Harvey Davis Primary Contact were made by a motion from Councilman Tony Valdez, seconded by Councilwoman O'Neal. The motion was carried out unanimously.
