a.) Discuss and possibly take action regarding Hays Commons Development Application to the City of Austin to provide water, wastewater and other services.

b.) Consider and take appropriate action regarding an agreement to hire Ardurra to be the Grant Manager for the 404 Hazard Mitigation Program.

Motion to pass agreement to hire Ardurra to be the Grant Manager and for Mayor Davis to sign the agreement for the 404 Hazard Mtigation Program was made by Mayor Pro Tem Bryan-Valdez and seconded by Councilwoman Blake. Motion carried unanimously.

c.) Consider and take appropriate action on request to approve a contract with Bee Cave Drilling to drill a new well and cap the old well at 536 Country Lane.

Motion to accept and approve Bee Cave Drilling to drill a new well and cap the old well at 536 Country Lane, estimated at \$138,174.69, Contract No. 138174.69 and subject to a Performance Bond to not exceed bid amount by 5%, was made by Mayor Pro Tem Bryan-Valdez. Councilwoman Hudgens seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Motion to include Performance Bond to the Bee Cave estimate to be about \$4- \$6,000.00 was made by Councilman Valdez and seconded by Councilwoman Hudgens. Motion was carried unanimously.

Motion to authorize Mayor Davis as council to execute the contract with Bee Cave Drilling and with City Engineer Rauschuber was made by Mayor Pro Tem Bryan-Valdez and seconded by Councilwoman Hudgens. Motion was carried unanimously.
