#### **City Council Filing Still Open**

Three positions are up for election on the City Council; Places 1, 4, and 5 held by Candace Blake, Lydia Bryan Valdez and Tom Lemman, respectively. The deadline for filing is February 14 at 5 p.m. at City Hall. Candidates must be at least 18 years old; hold US citizenship; have lived in Texas at least 12 months and the City of Hays at least 6 months; and currently be registered to vote at your City of Hays address.

A candidate application for a place on the ballot must: be in writing; be signed and sworn to by the candidate before a person authorized to administer an oath in this state, and indicating the date that the candidate swears to the application; be timely filed with the appropriate authority; and include all statutorily required information.

# **Milestone-Hays Commons Update**

The meeting between Milestone Community Builders and the City of Austin Planning Committee was postponed till January 28. These developers of Hays Commons are requesting the 498-acre property right next to us be annexed by the City of Austin and to be provided water and wastewater for 700+homes. They are also asking for an unprecedented exception to the SOS regulations, allowing them to increase impervious surface area from 15 to 25%.
